SECTION TWO

-  Training for the Ride must be completed before the ride attendant can properly run the ride.
-  They are to be trained on the operations of the unit and all the safety rules.
-  When the training is completed by any trained personal they are to sign the Rules sheet.
-  Any person running the ride must be present at all times and can train others to run the unit as long as they sign a Rules sheet stating that they were properly trained.

SECTION SIX

- ✚ The blower must run continuously while the Kiddie Korner is in use.
- ✚ If the air pressure seems low, determine if the air supply tube is straight and is securely fastened around the neck of the blower.
 - ⦿ An occasional check for this condition will help prevent this problem.
- ✚ If the Kiddie Korner begins to deflate:
 - ⦿ Remove participants
 - ⦿ Check supply tube
- ✚ If no power to the blower:
 - ⦿ Check that the power cord & extension cords are plugged into the wall outlet.
 - ⦿ Check circuit box for a tripped breaker.
- ✚ The Kiddie Korner MUST be attended at all times when in use.
- ✚ All participants MUST remove their shoes
- ✚ The attendants should be positioned at the front & one in the back for the best view of the participants
- ✚ Two participants may race through the unit at a time.
- ✚ Once both participants reach the top of the slide the next group may go.
- ✚ No one is permitted to jump from the top, roll down, or go head first down the slide.
 - ⦿ This could cause personal injury to you and to the others on the ride.
- ✚ Do not let anyone run up the slide surface at any time.
- ✚ No more than two participants on the slide at one time.
 - ⦿ **NO EXCEPTIONS!!!**

SECTION SEVEN

Folding / Rolling



Step 1: Fold Material neatly towards middle



Step 2: Fold over to form a rectangle



Step 3: Fold left side to the middle



Step 4: Fold right side all the way over & walk the air out towards the blower tube




Step 5: Roll tight, keep the roll lined up and tuck any extra material.



Step 6: Tuck in Port (Blower tube) and tie in off roll.

SECTION THREE

- ✦ A pre-opening inspection form must be filled out before the Kiddie Korner is put into service.
- ✦ The location chosen for the use of the Kiddie Korner must be a relatively flat, smooth surface free of overhead obstructions.
- ✦ Wood floor, concrete, asphalt, or grass surface needs a tarp under the unit
- ✦ *** NO GRAVEL, ROCKS, OR OTHER OBJECTS SHOULD BE UNDER THE UNIT!
- ✦ The blower should be no further than 50 feet from a 110 volt, 20 amps, dedicated grounded electrical outlet.
- ✦ 1, 12 gauge or heavier, 50' extension cord will be provided with each motor.
- ✦ The dimensions of the Kiddie Korner are 15'L x 15' W x 18'H
- ✦ You should have at least ten feet of clearance around the unit.
- ✦ The Kiddie Korner has to be anchored.
- ✦ Stakes for outdoor, sand bags for indoor use will be provided.
- ✦ All Velcro flaps should be checked before each event.
- ✦ Lay down a tarp in the area chosen then unroll the Kiddie Korner.
- ✦ Attach the motor to the supply tube using the attached strap or use the strap that was used to tie the rolled up ride.
- ✦ When the motor is properly secured & the flaps are closed, the blower can be turned on to inflate the Kiddie Korner.
- ✦ The Kiddie Korner will take 3-5 minutes to inflate to proper pressure.
- ✦ If it takes longer, then check the top flap or there may be a kink in the supply tube.
- ✦ Securing the Kiddie Korner is required with 4 Straight Stakes (grass surface) or 4 Sandbags (hard surface).

SECTION FIVE

-  Set the Kiddie Korner up in the manor described in the set up section.
-  Do a pre-opening inspection for the Kiddie Korner before it is in service.
-  Be sure that the Kiddie Korner is properly inflated.
-  Have all spectators stand at a safe distance.
-  Do Not let the spectators sit or lean on the Kiddie Korner.
-  Do Not operate in bad weather (Rain, Lightning, or Wind more than 15mph)
-  Be sure the Kiddie Korner is properly anchored.
-  No body contact between participants.
-  Do Not bounce against the walls.
-  No Flips
-  Do not use the Kiddie Korner without a properly trained attendant present.
-  Follow all the rules that are posted on the side of the Kiddie Korner.

Kiddie Korner Obstacle Course Rules



- ⦿ No is permitted on the ride without the trained attendant present.
- ⦿ The activity is physically challenging no one with any visible health problems is permitted on the activity.
- ⦿ All participants must remove their shoes and glasses before entering the activity.
- ⦿ The participants are to move through the activity to the end and exit.
- ⦿ Make sure that the people have existed before the next group goes.
- ⦿ No rough play will be permitted on the event.
- ⦿ No jumping off of the climbing wall.
- ⦿ Do not allow the participants to exit the event from the sides.
- ⦿ A check of the motors and the inflatable should be made to insure the safety of the riders. If a problem is noted then the ride should be secured and the event manager notified.
